

## **Folding instructions:**



- 1. Fold the A3 zine into eight sections by folding in half, quarters and then into eights.
- 2. Open the zine out. You can either score down the two centre sections, following the cut lines on our diagram, or fold in half and cut along the middle fold with scissors as pictured above.
- 3. Fold the paper lengthwise along the cut edge. Holding the paper at each end, push into the centre so that it look like a plus sign from the top.
- 4. The sections should now fold into each other to form an A6 zine.
